

## **The Israel Reform Movement is Seeking to Hire a Deputy Director General, Development and Overseas Relations**

The Israel Movement for Reform and Progressive Judaism (IMPJ) is the umbrella organization of the Reform Jewish congregations and institutions in Israel. The movement is active in diverse and important areas of Israeli society, as well as in the Diaspora. In recent years, the IMPJ has launched important initiatives in the field of Israeli Judaism, public life, and thought. It also plays a vital and central role in nurturing and strengthening the bond between Diaspora Jews and Israel. In response to this rapid growth, and due to the urgent need to develop the movement's main fields of activity, we are now seeking a deputy director who will be responsible for overseas relations and resource development.

### **Areas of Responsibility and Key Tasks**

- Overall responsibility for implementation and management in the fields of resource development in Israel and abroad and relations with government ministries, foundations in Israel and abroad, Jewish Federations and private donors.
- Responsibility for the Israel Reform Movement's activities in the field of Israel-Diaspora relations.
- Working relations with the National Institutions (Jewish Agency, KKL-JNF, World Zionist Organization, and Keren Hayesod) and organizations abroad, including partner movements around the world etc.
- Participation in the senior management teams and think tanks of the Israel Reform Movement.
- Staff management and budget management in the relevant fields of activity.

- Proven and successful experience in resource development and overseas relations in a significant Israeli organization
- In-depth familiarity with the world of philanthropy in general, and Israeli philanthropy, in particular

- Familiarity with Reform Judaism in North America and the rest of the world.
- Knowledge of information systems and digital activity in the field of resource development
- Proven experience in staff management
- Affinity with the values of the Israel Reform Movement
- Excellent interpersonal skills
